

Ordinance
No. 12

An Ordinance prohibiting the raising or keeping of hogs or pigs, whether the same be kept in pens or otherwise, within the corporate limits of Leonardtown, and to provide a penalty for violations of the same.

Section 1.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Commissioners of Leonardtown that no hogs or pigs shall be raised or kept within the corporate limits of Leonardtown, whether in pens or otherwise, and any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance, shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not less than \$5.00, and costs, nor more than \$25.00, and costs, and when said fine and costs are not paid the party convicted and fined shall be committed to the St. Mary's County Jail for a period not exceeding 10 days, or until discharged in due course of law.

Section 2.

Be it further enacted and ordained by the authority aforesaid that this Ordinance shall take effect from the date of its passage.
