Whereas, the current Zoning Ordinance heretofore adopted and currently in effect shall be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

§ 155-4. Definitions.

ACCESSORY USE OR BUILDING - A secondary land use or building customarily incidental to and located on the same lot occupied by the primary use or building. Such accessory building shall not be used for housekeeping purposes. Accessory buildings include, but are not limited to, sheds, unenclosed decks, detached garages, and gazebos.
