

Ordinance
No. 15

An Ordinance to provide for the elections of members of The Commissioners of Leonardtown and the appointment of a judge of such elections, his compensation and duties.

Section 1.

Be it enacted and ordained by The Commissioners of Leonardtown that the regular annual election of members of The Commissioners of Leonardtown shall take place on the first Tuesday of May annually, and that the polls shall be opened at the Court House in Leonardtown between the hours of One P.M. and Six P.M., and that a resident Justice of the Peace or some resident of said town shall be designated by The Commissioners of Leonardtown to be the judge of said election, and to make the returns thereof, and he shall receive as compensation for his services such sum as may be set by the said Commissioners, the same not to exceed the sum of Five Dollars. In case of a vacancy among the members of The Commissioners of Leonardtown, the election to fill said vacancy shall take place at such time as a majority of the remaining Commissioners shall direct in the manner herein prescribed for a general election.

Section 2.

And be it further enacted and ordained by the authority aforesaid that this Ordinance shall take effect from the date of its passage.
