

Ordinance  
No. 19

An Ordinance to prohibit all unsanitary or dangerous accumulations or deposits of trash, garbage or other waste materials upon any private property, within the corporate limits of Leonardtown, and to provide a penalty for violations of the same.

Section 1.

Be it enacted and ordained by The Commissioners of Leonardtown, that no person, firm or corporation, shall permit any unsanitary or dangerous accumulations or deposits of trash, garbage or other waste materials upon his property, within the corporate limits of Leonardtown; provided that any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not less than \$1.00 and costs, nor more than \$10.00 and costs, and in default of fine shall be committed to the St. Mary's County jail for a period not exceeding Ten days, or until discharged in due course of law.

Section 2.

Be it further enacted and ordained by the authority aforesaid that this Ordinance shall take effect from the date of its passage.
