

Ordinance  
No. 20

An Ordinance to prohibit the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors, except beer or other spirituous or fermented beverages containing less than 8% alcohol by volume, within the corporate limits of Leonardtown, on Sundays, election days, except days for the election of Commissioners of Leonardtown, or between the hours of 12 midnight and 6 A.M., on any other day and provide a penalty for violations of the same.

Section 1.

Be it enacted and ordained by The Commissioners of Leonardtown that no person, firm or corporation shall sell, offer for sale or otherwise dispose of any spirituous or fermented liquors, except beer or other spirituous or fermented beverages containing less than 8% alcohol by volume, within the corporate limits of Leonardtown, on Sundays, election days, except the days for the election of Commissioners of Leonardtown, or between the hours of 12 midnight and 6 A.M., on any other days. Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction be subjected to a fine of not less than \$10.00 and costs, nor more than \$25.00 and costs, and in default of fine shall be committed to the St. Mary's County jail for a period not exceeding Thirty days, or until discharged in due course of law.

Section 2. Be it further enacted and ordained by the authority aforesaid that this Ordinance shall take effect from the date of its passage.
