

Ordinance No. 66  
Authorization to Remove  
Illegally Parked Motor  
Vehicles From Town  
Parking Lots  
Effective Date:

An Ordinance to authorize and enable the Town of Leonardtown to tow , transport and otherwise remove illegally parked or abandoned motor vehicles from Town parking lots.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Leonardtown recognize and acknowledge the need to remove illegally parked or abandoned motor vehicles from Town parking lots.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF LEONARDTOWN, this 9th day of October, 1990, that the following is hereby adopted within the corporate limits of Leonardtown, Maryland.

SECTION 1:

That the Town of Leonardtown, by and through the Town Administrator, may authorize the removal and storage of any illegally parked or abandoned motor vehicle(s) present on Town parking lots.

SECTION 2:

Prior to said removal, the Town Administrator shall have placed upon said offending motor vehicle(s) notice of intent to remove at least seventy-two (72) hours prior to said removal.


SECTION 3:

That the owner(s) of said offending motor vehicle(s) shall reimburse the Town of Leonardtown for all reasonable costs associated with removing said motor vehicle(s) from Town parking lots before release of the vehicle to said owners(s).

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED AND ENACTED, that the Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage hereof.


