ORDINANCE: 70
EFFECTIVE DATE:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF LEONARDTOWN AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE TO REQUIRE THE INSTALLATION OF AUTOMATIC FIRE SPRINKLERS IN ALL NEW CONSTRUCTION.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of Leonardtown do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: The Municipal Code is amended as follows:

All occupancies: An automatic sprinkler system shall be installed and maintained in all new construction regardless of floor area or occupancy type. Residential or quick-response standard sprinklers shall be used in dwelling units and guest room portions of all buildings. All systems shall conform to the appropriate National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Standard 13, 13D, or 13R.

SECTION 2: Should any part, term or provision of this Ordinance be by a Court of competent jurisdiction decided to be illegal or in conflict with any law of the State where made, the validity of the remaining portions or provisions shall not be effected thereby.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effective thirty (30) days after its passage, and within fifteen (15) days after its passage it shall be published once in a newspaper of general circulation within St. Mary's County, Maryland.
