

Ordinance
No. 9.

An Ordinance to prohibit the parking of automobiles and other vehicles in certain areas, within the corporate limits of Leonardtown, which shall be designated by the Commissioners of Leonardtown as "no parking" or "restricted parking" areas and to provide a penalty for the destruction, removal or interference with any signs or markers placed or erected by The Commissioners of Leonardtown, their agents or servants, designating such areas.

Section 1.

Be it enacted and ordained by The Commissioners of Leonardtown that no person shall park any truck, bus, automobile, wagon, cart or other vehicle within the areas in the corporate limits of Leonardtown that have been, or may hereafter be restricted against parking and designated as "no parking" areas by The Commissioners of Leonardtown, nor shall any person park any such vehicles as aforesaid for a longer period of time than has been allowed, or may hereafter be allowed, by The Commissioners of Leonardtown, within the areas in the corporate limits of Leonardtown that shall be designated as limited parking areas; provided that such no parking areas or limited parking areas shall at all times be plainly designated by The Commissioners of Leonardtown by appropriate signs or markers placed conspicuously at the designated areas, and provided that any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance, as well as any person who shall willfully and intentionally deface, destroy or in any manner interfere with any signs or markers placed by The Commissioners of Leonardtown, its agents or servants, shall,

Section 1. Continued:

upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not less than \$ 1.00, nor more than \$ 30.00, and costs, and when said fine and costs are not paid, the party convicted and fined shall be committed to the St. Mary's County jail for a term not exceeding 30 days, or until discharged in due course of law.

Section 2.

And be it further enacted by and ordained by the authority aforesaid that this Ordinance shall take effect from the date of its passage.
