Subject: Subdivision Regulations

Purpose

For the purpose of amending the Code of Leonardtown in order to revise existing provisions.

Ordinance

Whereas, under the provisions of The Charter of the Town of Leonardtown, the Town Council of Leonardtown, is empowered to adopt, revise and amend necessary ordinances for the purpose of carrying out the powers granted in the Charter; and

Whereas, the current Subdivision Regulations in the Leonardtown Code heretofore adopted and currently in effect shall be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

131-10.A. By the first of the month prior to the regularly scheduled monthly meeting, the subdivider shall present to the Commission a preliminary subdivision plat prepared by a competent surveyor or land planner. Seven copies of the preliminary subdivision plat and street profiles shall be filed with the Commission, at a scale of one inch equals 100 feet and at a recommended size of 24 inches by 36 inches, showing the following information
