Resolution to Support Community Legacy Application for Elevator and Sprinklers at 22670 Washington Street

Resolution

Resolution of the Commissioners of Leonardtown approving the application and receipt of financing for a Community Legacy Project (the "Project") further described in the Application dated July 11, 2016 (the "Application"), to be financed either directly by the Department of Housing and Community Development (the "Department") of the State of Maryland or through other departments or agencies of the State of Maryland.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Leonardtown recognize that there is a significant need for reinvestment and revitalization of the communities in Leonardtown; and,

WHEREAS, the Department, either through Community Legacy, Community Legacy-Neighborhood Intervention, Strategic Demolition Fund, Baltimore Regional Neighborhood Initiative or through other Programs of the Department, or in cooperation with other State departments or agencies, may provide some or all of the financing for the Project (the "Project Financing") in order to assist in making it financially feasible; and

WHEREAS, the Project is located within a priority funding area under Section 5-7B-02 of the Smart Growth Act and the Project will conform to the local zoning code; and

WHEREAS, the applicable law and regulations require approval of the Project and the Project Financing by the Commissioners of Leonardtown and, where appropriate, by the chief elected executive official of the local subdivision;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Commissioners of Leonardtown hereby endorses the Project in the Sustainable Community Area; and, HEREBY approves the request for financial assistance in the form of a grant or loan, up to the amount of \$306,997 ; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the Mayor be, and is hereby requested to endorse this Resolution, thereby indicating his approval thereof; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, Mayor Daniel W. Burris is hereby authorized to execute documents and take any action necessary to carry out the intent of these resolutions; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, copies of this Resolution are sent to the Secretary of the Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland.
