Zoning Ordinance Text Amendment

Subject: Requiring SF Homes to have Paved Driveways

Purpose

For the purpose of amending the Zoning Ordinance of the Town of Leonardtown in order to revise existing provisions.

Ordinance

Whereas, under the provisions of Article 66B of the Annotated Code of Maryland, the Town Council of Leonardtown for Leonardtown, Maryland, is empowered to adopt, revise and amend the Leonardtown Zoning Ordinance; and

Whereas, the current Zoning Ordinance heretofore adopted and currently in effect shall be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

ARTICLE II. R-SF Single-Family Residential District

§ 155-13. Height, bulk and area requirements.

[Amended 5-9-2011 by Ord. No. 149]

All standards are summarized in Chart A, Height, Area and Bulk Requirements. *Editor's Note: Chart A is included at the end of this chapter.* All uses, structures and buildings listed as permitted or approved as special exception in this district shall be located on a lot having a net area of at least 10,000 square feet, with a minimum lot width of 70 feet and a minimum lot depth of 100 feet. The front yard shall have a minimum depth of 25 feet, a minimum width of each of two side yards of eight feet, and a total aggregate width of 18 feet for both side yards, and a minimum depth of rear yard of 25 feet.

Paved Driveways Required

All new single-family, two-family or multi-family residential structures having ingress or egress off of a public street must have paved driveways, turn-arounds and parking areas constructed of concrete or hot mix asphalt. A certificate of occupancy will not be issued until a paved driveway in compliance with Town code has been constructed.
