Ordinance No. 18

An Ordinance to require all hucksters, hawkers and peddlers selling any goods, wares or merchandise, within the corporate limits of Leonardtown, except farmers or growers selling their own products which have been grown or raised in St. Mary's County, to obtain a permit from the Commissioners of Leonardtown, and providing a penalty for violations of the same.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by The Commissioners of Leonardtown that no hucksters, hawkers or peddlers shall sell, offer for sale or solicit the sale of any goods, wares or merchandise, within the copporate limits of Leonardtown, until he shall have applied for and obtained a permit from the Commissioners of Leonardtown, which said permit shall expire after twelve months from the date of its issuance, provided, however, that this ordinance shall not apply to farmers or growers selling their own products which have been grown or raised in St. Mary's County, Maryland. Application for permits shall be filed with the Treasurer for the Commissioners of Leonardtown and shall be accompanied by a fee of \$10.00, which shall be the fee for each such permit; and any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not less than \$20.00 and costs, nor more than \$50.00 and costs, and in default of fine shall be committed to the St. Mary's County jail for a period not exceeding Ten Days, or until discharged in due course of law.

Be it further enacted and ordained by the authority aforesaid that this Ordinance shall take effect from the
