AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 29, FIRE HYDRANTS

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Leonardtown recognize the need to amend Chapter 75 of The Leonardtown Code, Ordinance 29, Fire Hydrants,

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Commissioners of Leonardtown that, Chapter 75 of the Leonardtown Code, Ordinance No. 29, Fire Hydrants, heretofore passed by the Commissioners of Leonardtown on August 1, 1964, is hereby amended and revised as follows:

§ 75-2. Issuance of permit.

The written permit required by this chapter shall be obtained from the Clerk, Treasurer, or other duly authorized official or employee of the Commissioners of Leonardtown and may be issued at the discretion of said Commissioners. Such permit shall specify the method of measurement, duration of time which it shall be in effect, and the rate per gallon to be paid by the holder thereof for water drawn from such hydrants. Water drawn under the terms of any such permit shall be only drawn from such hydrants as specified by the Town.

§ 75-4. Violations and penalties.

Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in an amount not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500.) or be imprisoned in the county jail for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days, or be both so fined and imprisoned. Each occurrence of water withdrawal which violates the provisions of this chapter and/or terms of the written permit shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as such hereunder.

And be it further enacted and ordained by the aforesaid authority that this ordinance shall take effect the 1st of January, 1995.
