An Ordinance to provide for the creation of a Planning Commission, to be known as "Leonardtown Planning
Commission", as provided by Sections 11 and 12 of Article
66B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957) as amended.

## Section 1:

Whereas, by Sections 11 and 12 of Article 66B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957), as amended, the Commissioners of Leonardtown were authorized and empowered, among other things, to create a Planning Commission to consist of five members, four of whom to be appointed by said Commissioners of Leonardtown and the fifth member to be named from said Commissioners of Leonardtown ex-officio. Section 2:

Therefore, be it enacted and ordained by the Commissioners of Leonardtown, this 4th day of April, 1967, that a Planning Commission is hereby created and designated to be known as the "Leonardtown Planning Commission" to consist of five members, four of whom shall be appointed by the Commissioners of Leonardtown to serve without compensation and the fifth to be a member of the said Commissioners of Leonardtown. The term of the ex-officio member shall correspond to his elected term. The term of each member appointed shall be five years or until his successor takes office, except that the respective terms of the five members first appointed shall be one, two, three, four and five years. Members may, after a public hearing, be dismissed by the Commissioners of Leonardtown for inefficiency, neglect of duty or malfeasance in office. Commissioners of Leonardtown shall file a written statement of reasons for such dismissal. Vacancies occurring otherwise than through the expiration of the term shall be filled for the unexpired term by the said Commissioners of Leonardtown.

## Section 3:

The Leonardtown Planning Commission shall possess the powers and duties as set forth in Article 66B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957) as amended.

Section 4:

And be it further enacted that this Ordinance shall take effect as of the date of its passage and enactment.
