AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AN EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF LEONARDTOWN, MARYLAND FOR GARBAGE COLLECTION AND FOR THE REGULATION OF SUCH ACTIVITY

ARTICLE ONE GRANT OF FRANCHISE

The Commissioners of Leonardtown, Maryland, a municipal corporation (hereinafter referred to as Grantor) hereby grants to WALTER WISE, T/A Disposal / (hereinafter referred to as Grantee) an exclusive franchise for the collection of garbage within the corporate limits of Leonardtown, Maryland, of the following scope and description:

ARTICLE TWO SCOPE AND DESCRIPTION OF FRANCHISE

The Grantee has the exclusive right during the term of the franchise granted by this Ordinance to collect and haul for hire over the streets and alleys of the Grantor all garbage collected from public and private customers located within the corporate limits of the Grantor. "Garbage," as used herein, shall be interpreted to mean and include all waste animal and vegetable matter, ruttish, trash, debris, ashes, tin cans and other waste materials generally, including articles ordinarily and sustemarily hauled away and dumped.

The Grantee shall dump garbage hauled hereliter at such locations beyond the Grantor's corporate limits as shall be approved by the St. Mary's County Health Department and other applicable County agencies.

ARTICLE THREE SPECIFIC CONDITIONS

Section 1. Frequency of Collections. The Grantee shall collect garbage from various residential, commercial and public facilities at the same frequency as set forth in the existing collection schedule, attached hereto and incorporated by reference

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herein. The Grantee may select other dates for collection and may vary the frequency of collection from various customers by mutual agreement between the Grantee and the individual customers.

Section 2. Furnishing of Service. Grantee shall be required to furnish collection service to any person or organization, public or private, within the corporate limits of the Grantor after receipt of a written request for such service. The Grantee shall offer new customers the frequency of collection available to other, similar customers.

Section 3. Garbage Trucks. All trucks used by the Grantee for the collection and hauling of garbage shall be maintained in safe operating condition at all times. Each truck shall be equipped with a closed body that incorporates a hydraulically operated device for compacting collected garbage.

Section 4. Compliance with Regulations. The Grantee shall comply with all ordinances and regulations adopted or to be adopted by the Grantor pertaining to the collection, hauling and disposal of garbage within the corporate limits of the Grantor or regulating the use of the streets or alleys therefor.

Section 5. Labor and Equipment. The Grantee shall provide adequate labor and equipment for garbage collection under this franchise in order to provide for the reasonable and proper collection and disposal of garbage within the Grantor's corporate limits, at the Grantee's expense. Other than for expenses incurred by the Grantor in billing customers, as set forth below, all expenses associated with operating the garbage collection system under this franchise shall be the sole responsibility of the Grantee.

ARTICLE FOUR TERM

The franchise is granted for a term of five (5) years, commencing with the date on which it is accepted, subject to the right of termination set forth below. After the initial term, the

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franchise may be renewed on such terms and conditions as may be mutually acceptable to the Grantor and Grantee.

The Grantee shall file a written acceptance of the franchise, using a form approved by the Grantor, with the Grantor's Town Administrator within five (5) days after the date of this Ordinance. The franchise shall go into effect only when such acceptance has been duly filed with the Grantor, together with the letter of credit, all necessary federal, state and local permits, and evidence of general comprehensive liability insurance, as required below.

ARTICLE FIVE GENERAL CONDITIONS

Section 1. Letter of Credit. The Grantee shall, within five (5) days after the date of this Ordinance, file with the Grantor's Town Administrator, and at all times during the term of this franchise keep in full force and effect, a letter of credit payable to the Grantor's order, in the amount of Twenty-Five Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$25,000.00). The Grantor reserves the right to approve both the form of the letter of credit and the issuing financial institution. The letter of credit shall recite that it is being issued for the purpose of insuring the Grantee's faithful percormance of its duties and ordinations under the franchise. Neither the letter of credit nor any amounts recovered unter it shall be construed to excuse the Grantee's faithful performance under the franchise, nor limit the liability of the Grantee for damages, or preclude the Grantor from exercising any other remedies available at law or equity.

Section 2. Indemnity. The Grantee shall indemnify and defend the Grantor, its boards, commissions, officers, agents and employees, against any and all liabilities for injury to or death of any person or persons, or any damage to or destruction of any property caused in whole or in part by the Grantee, its officers, agents and employees, during its exercise of the franchise.

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Section 3. Comprehensive Liability Insurance. At all times during the term of the franchise the Grantee will, at its own expense, maintain in full force and effect comprehensive liability insurance with an insurance company approved by the Grantor, and with the policy or policies to be approved by the Grantor. The coverage represented by such policy or policies shall be for the protection of the Grantor, members of its boards and commissions, and its officers, agents and employees, against any liability for loss or damages for bodily injury, death and property damage or destruction caused by the activities of the Grantee under the franchise. Minimum liability limits under the policy or policies shall be three million dollars (\$3,000,000.00) for personal injury or death and/or damage to property resulting from any one (1) occurrence. At the Grantor's request, additional public agencies and their personnel shall be added as insured parties. The abovedescribed policy or policies shall each contain a provision that a written notice of any cancellation or reduction in coverage shall be delivered to the Grantor at least fifteen (15) days in advance of the effective date thereof. The Grantee shall provide the Grantor with certificates evidencing the insurance coverage described above at least annually.

Section 4. Limitation of Franchise. No privilege or exemption is granted of tenferred by the franchise except those specifically prescribed nerein. Any privilege claimed under the franchise by the Grantee in any street, alley or other public place shall be subordinate to any lawful occupancy of same by the Grantor or by any other public agency, and to lawful prior occupancy of same by any other entity or person.

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ARTICLE SIX CONSIDERATION

Section 1. Compensation. The compensation to be paid by the Grantor to the Grantee for the services under this franchise shall be as set forth in the Proposal from the Grantee to the Grantor dated October 27, 1983. A copy of siad Proposal is attached hereto and incorporated by reference *herein. Such compensation shall remain in effect until June 30. 1985. Beginning in January, 1985, the Grantor and Grantee shall conduct an annual rate review, effective July 1 of the same year. event the parties shall fail to reach agreement on the annual rate review prior to March 31 of any year, this franchise shall null and void on July 1 of that year, subject to such extensions to which the parties may mutually agree.

Section 2. Billing. The Grantee shall submit an invoice monthly to the Grantor for services provided during the previous month under the franchise. The amount so invoiced and approved by the Grantor shall be paid by the Grantor to the Grantee. All invoices shall specify any changes in type of collection or customers served from the attached list of existing customers. The amount invoiced shall reflect any such changes. The Grantor assumes the responsibility of billing the individual customers for services rendered by the Grantee under the franchise. gut after 1985, the Grantor may, at its option, transfer sustomer tilling to the Grantee, which shall then relieve the Grantor from any further financial responsibility to the Grantes under Section 1, above. Provided, however, that transfer of direct customer billing to the Grantee shall not terminate the Grantor's right to review and approve any prospective rate increases, as set forth above.

ARTICLE SEVEN ASSIGNMENT OF FRANCHISE

The Grantee shall not have the right to assign the franchise or otherwise transfer it in any manner whatsoever, or sell, lease, license or permit others to use or transfer in any manner

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whatsoever any interest in all or any part of its facilities that are installed or operated hereunder, except upon prior written approval of the Grantor.

ARTICLE EIGHT FORFEITURE AND TERMINATION

The franchise may be forfeited, at the option of the Grantor, upon failure or refusal by the Grantee to observe the terms and conditions set forth herein. Forfeiture may be exercised by written notice to the Grantee of failure to observe the terms and conditions hereof, followed by the Grantee's refusal to eliminate or correct such failure or violation within thirty (30) days, or to commence the elimination or correction of such failure within twenty-four (24) hours of notice from the Grantor. In the event of any failure or violation, the Grantor may sue in its own name in the manner provided by law for the forfeiture of the franchise, and the exercise of such remedy of forfeiture shall not preclude the exercise of any other right or remedy give to the Grantor by law or equity, whether exercised concurrently or subsequently. Either the Grantor or the Grantee may terminate its obligations under this franchise upon giving the other party at least six (6) months written notice prior to July 1, which shall be the effective date of termination.

ARTICLE NIÑE: EFFECT: OF INVALIDATE

The franchise is granted pursuent to the laws of the State of Maryland relating to the granting of such rights and privileges by municipal corporations. If any article, section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance or any of the remaining portions. The invalidity of any portion of this Ordinance shall not abate, reduce or otherwise affect any consideration or other obligation required of the Grantee.

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This franchise shall be effective on the 1st day of December, 1983.
