MULTI-FAMILY DWELLINGS IN COMMERCIAL DISTRICTS

EFFECTIVE DATE: September 8, 1986

TEXT AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE PERMITTING MULTI-FAMILY DWELLINGS IN COMMERICAL DISTRICTS

WHEREAS, the Citizens of Leonardtown wish to encourage a thriving community,

WHEREAS, pedestrian activity promotes a lively commercial area, WHEREAS, residences in the commercial area promote pedestrian traffic in the evening hours.

WHEREAS, multiple-family dwellings exist as non-conforming uses under the present Zoning Ordinance,

WHEREAS, adequate on-street parking in commercial areas is limited, WHEREAS, following duly published notice, the Planning and Zoning Board and the Commissioners of Leonardtown conducted a joint public hearing on September 8, 1986,

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Board recommends multiple-family occupancy in Commercial Districts where off-street parking requirements can be met,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Commissioners of Leonard-town this 8th day of September, 1986, that the following Amendments, which add the classification 'Multiple-Family dwellings' to the list of permitted uses in all commercial areas, conditioned upon demonstration of strict compliance with the off-street parking requirements of Article 13 be and hereby are adopted and incorporated into the Leonardtown Zoning Ordinance:

Section 9-1 Permitted Uses

12. Multiple-Family dwellings, conditioned upon demonstration of strict compliance with the off-street parking requirements of Article 13.

Section 10-1 Permitted Uses

8. Multiple-Family dwellings, conditioned upon demonstration of strict compliance with the off-street parking requirements of Article 13 as modified by subsection 7 above.

Section 11-1 Permitted Uses

10. Multiple-Family dwellings, conditioned upon strict compliance with the off-street parking requirements of Article 13.

Section 12-1 Permitted Uses

9. Multiple-Family dwellings conditioned upon strict compliance with the off-street parking requirements of Article 13.
