An Ordinance to prohibit any person from riding, driving or leading any live stock, whether attached to a vehicle or not, or driving any motor vehicle or motor cycle upon and along any of the public sidewalks within the Corporate Limits of Leonardtown and to provide a penalty for violations of the same.

Section 1.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Commissioners of Leonardtown, that no person shall ride, drive or lead any livestock, whether attached to a vehicle or not, or drive any motor vehicle or motor cycle, upon and along any of the public sidewalks within the corporate limits of Leonardtown; provided that any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not less than \$1.00 and costs, nor more than \$10.00 and costs, and when said fine and costs are not paid, the party convicted and fined shall be committed to the St. Mary's County jail for a period not exceeding Ten Days, or until discharged in due course of law.

Section 2.

Be it further enacted and ordained by the authority aforesaid that this Ordinance shall take effect from the date of its passage.
